Seasonal Landscape Management

Irrigation Efficiency

- Lawn irrigation can be 40 to 60% of your water bill
- Watering less than two times a week is usually sufficient
- Brown grass does not mean dead grass
- Frequent watering promotes shallow roots instead of deep, long-lasting roots
- Use Manual mode as needed
- Running irrigation systems in freezing weather could cause hazardous ice patches

April 1 through October 31

- Water no more than twice per week
- Less than twice per week is usually adequate
- Watering is prohibited from 10 am to 6 pm.
- Additional Landscape watering may be provided by a hand-held hose with a shutoff nozzle, dedicated irrigation drip zones, and/or soaker hose provided no runoff occurs.

November 1 through March 31

- Limit landscape watering to one day per week
- Every 15 to 20 days is usually adequate
